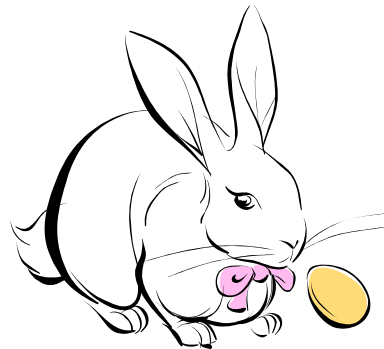

General Meeting CDC, March 10, 2007

The January General meeting minutes were approved as published in the February Spot News, motion made by Tom Kaiser, seconded by Meg Hennessey.

Treasurer Mike Hennessey presented the Treasurer report for Jan and Feb 2007. The format of the report was redesigned to now include a 1 page Account Balance summary showing totals for our checking account, as well as all our other accounts. Also, the detailed income/expense reports for January and February were presented as well as the 2006 Specialty report and the income/expense report for CDC's fiscal year of Jan 1 2006 thru Dec 31, 2006. The Audit committee of Sue Olsen, Irene Jinks and Ray Plaza worked with Treasurer Mike Hennessey to develop the new format and audited the 2006 reports. The January and February reports will be submitted for Audit.

Membership and Press & Publicity had no reports. Spot News Chair Meg Hennessey reported that Sharon Podleski will be submitting an article on Puppy training. Meg also requested that if anyone would like to submit an article to the Spot News or has ideas on some topics for the Spot News, to please contact her.

Dal Research Chair Ginger Iwaoka reported that we are still collecting 'weight circles' for DCAF. Each club will receive 25% of the cash value of the weight circles, and the club with the highest amount collected will receive 50%. The details of the program were previously published in the Spot News. The Purina Weight Circles should be sent to Laura Kiedaisch, and Laura reports that she has received circles totaling about 400lb of food. Ginger also reported that she had heard from Cheryl Bryant on the treatment she received for her dog's urinary blockage from Purdue. The procedure included back flushing and a laser treatment (Lithotripsy) vs. the normal surgery procedure. A few other members also commented on the high standard of treatment they received from the West Lafayette Purdue University clinic. Ginger also reported on a study that was being started at Purdue to research which dog foods provide the best results after a urinary stone procedure. A motion was made by Sue Olsen, seconded by Meg Hennessey, to fund this study with a \$100.00 donation. Also, CDC would retain the rights to publish the results of this study. Ginger will submit an article to the Spot News on the study when the results are known.

Library Chair Don Wageman reported on the status of the library, and a discussion on discontinuing the library was re-opened from our January meeting. A motion was made by Meg Hennessey, seconded by Lisa Wageman, to sell the entire CDC library at CDC's picnic. The cost will be determined, but will be very reasonable. Any books not sold will be donated or sold in bulk on the Internet. Also, the library has some tapes from past DCA shows and instructional videos that will also be offered for sale.

President Gail Meyers reported that Yvonne McPherson will not be able to be our Fun Match chair this year due to health concerns. Ginger Iwaoka volunteered and will assume the Fun Match Chairmanship.

Ad service, Way & Means and Program had no reports.

Social Chair Jody Lynn Stuppy reported that Donna Erickson and Adam Katolick were married on Feb 24. Currently there is a policy for sending members a gift only for illness and deaths of family members. A lengthy discussion followed to expand the scope of these gifts. A motion was made by Meg Hennessey, seconded by Kris Carlsson, and was passed by the membership to send a \$50.00 gift to members on the birth of a child and when a member weds. A motion was made by Tom Kaiser, seconded by Ginger Iwaoka, and passed by the membership to limit the wedding/birth gifts to active members, as described in the by-laws.

Pedigree Co-Chair Tom Kaiser reported that the Pedigree Books were scheduled to ship from the publisher on March 17, and should be shipped to those who ordered books shortly after that. A motion was made by Ginger, seconded by Tom Kaiser to donate 2 sets of the 2007 Pedigree Book to the DCAF raffle.

Policy & Procedure had no report.

Show Chairman Kris Carlsson reported that we have a signed contract from the Obedience judge and we will sign the contract for the site in the next week. Also Kris is looking for suggestions for this year's trophies, please contact either Kris

Sue Olsen reported that the Audit committee had completed their 2006 audit. Kris Carlsson thanked all for their help with lunch at the IKC Specialty.

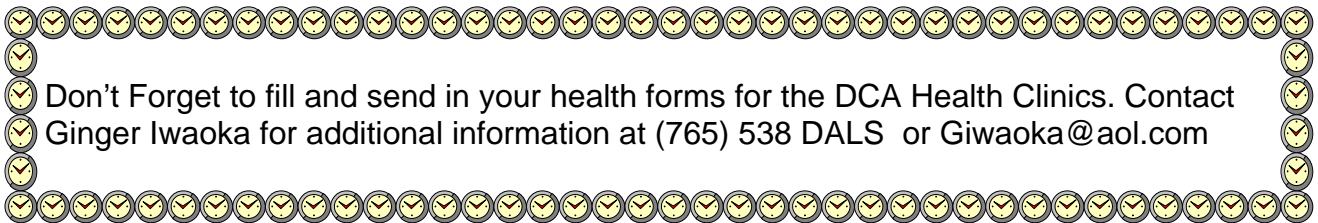
New Business: The club discussed a donation to the DCA Performance Fund, for which is would receive a DCA print. Meg reported that the annual \$300.00

While it may have seemed near effortless with your first dog, how can you ensure a close bond with the rest of the dogs in your home? With patience, you can build an equally good relationship with all dogs in your home.

- ☺ Give all your dogs the same level of attention, setting aside time every day to train and play with each dog individually.
- ☺ Develop and enforce consistent rules for food, toys, play and walks, maintaining the same rules for all dogs to prevent confusion. Equally reward all dogs for good behavior in each other's presence.
- ☺ Establish a strong leadership position with new dogs. Take an active role in teaching house rules and proper behavior instead of allowing older dogs to step into a stronger leadership role, which can cause conflict and confusion between dogs.
- ☺ Observe playtime, and maintain your leadership position by stopping play if it becomes too rough for any dog, if one is mouthing the other, or if it is not enjoyable for one of the dogs.
- ☺ To avoid unnecessary fighting, feed dogs separately. Also, give a new dog his food or toys separately until all of the dogs can interact appropriately together.
