Reports of Committees:

Show: Tom Kaiser reported that we are waiting for a letter from Wheaton Kennel Club to reach AKC; this is the letter indicating that they agree that we may hold a show at the same time and site as they do. We have contracts from the judges. There will be no judges' education. Lisa Wageman will be in charge of lunches, with information to be in Spot News and the show premium. Kris Benoit is handling trophies; members are reminded to contribute for purchase of trophies.

New Business:

Revision of CDC Bylaws, as published in the Spot News, was presented. It was moved by Irene Jinks, seconded by Meg Hennessey, that the revised bylaws be adopted. There was some discussion as to the length of continuous membership required to have honorary life membership granted. It was pointed out that a change had been made in 2006 to reduce the number of years from forty-five to forty, but no further changes had been approved. With no further discussion, the revisions were approved as presented.
