There was discussion of whether or not to hold a raffle. There seems to be a lack of interest in Dalmatian related items which have been part of past raffles. We also need to look at the logistics of the site as to whether a regular raffle would be feasible.

Judges' Education: There will be no judges' education at our show next year. It could be done at the IKC show or could be a presentation at a club meeting.

Hospitality: It was suggested that we might have a pot-luck at the September fun match.

No other business was presented. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
